



# HOPPING SPRING BUNNIES CRAFT printable



## HELLO!

Time to bring joy to your spring season with this delightful bunny craft! Kids will love pulling the string to make the bunny's ears hop up and down. Perfect for both home and classroom settings, this activity is sure to spark creativity! Here are some helpful tips for crafting and playing. Enjoy!



## INCLUDED

- Bunny template coloring page
- Bunny template for drawing
- Instruction page



## CRAFT SUPPLIES

- A (color) printer or printing service
- Scissors, glue
- Colored pencils or markers
- 2 split pins and hole puncher
- Yarn and (Jumbo popsicle) stick

## STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather the craft supplies above. Use the printable as a coloring page or draw your own bunny face on the blanco template. Important: We highly recommend using thicker (heavier) printing paper. This makes the crafting process easier for little hands and the craft more durable, allowing the ears to move freely.
2. Time to color your bunny! Position the egg-shaped head with the small part up. You can add details like a heart-shaped nose, eyes and whiskers. Use crayons, pencils, or colored markers. In addition, you can use colored paper or googly eyes for decoration.
3. Create the holes to move your bunny. **Bunny's head:** Punch two holes at the top marked with a red X. **Ears:** Make one small hole on top (for the yarn) and punch one larger hole below. Bove marked with a red X.
4. Assemble the bunny by attaching ears to the head with a split pin. Connect the ears with yarn through the small holes and tie in the middle. Add a long string to pull and move the ears. For more details check our blogpost (QR-code).
5. Let's finish our bunny puppet! Start by gluing the bunny face to a stick. This lets you hold it while pulling the string to make it hop! We used Jumbo popsicle sticks, but a stick from outside or strong cardboard works too.

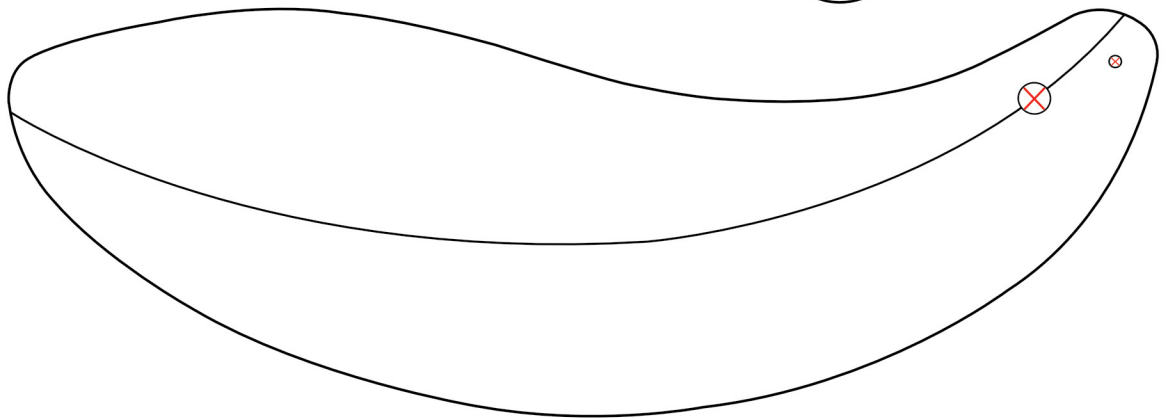
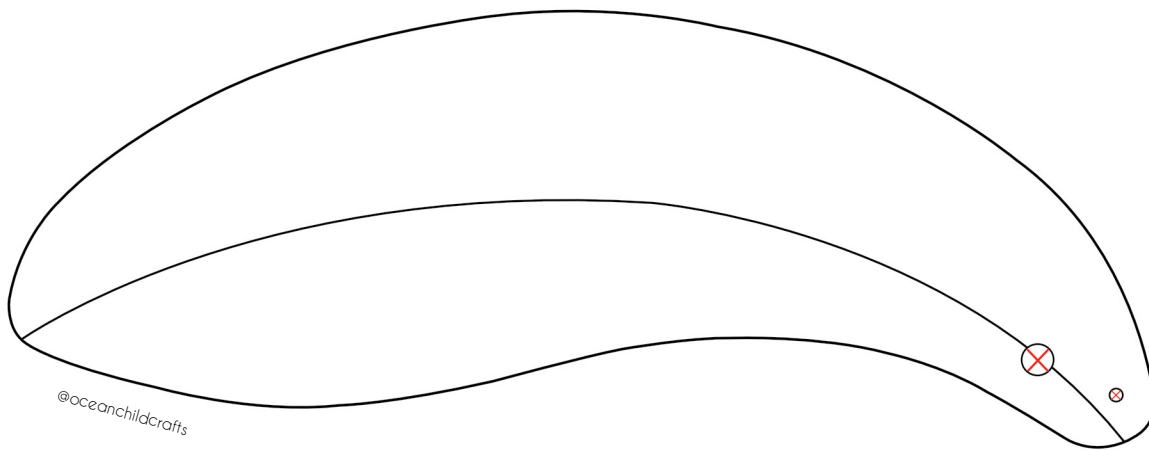
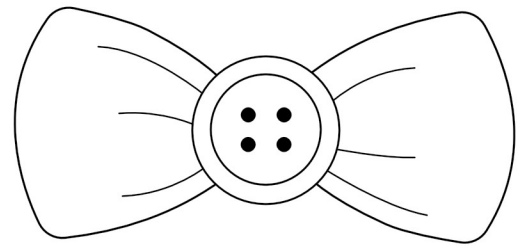
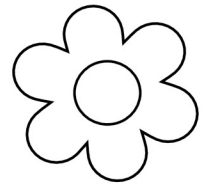
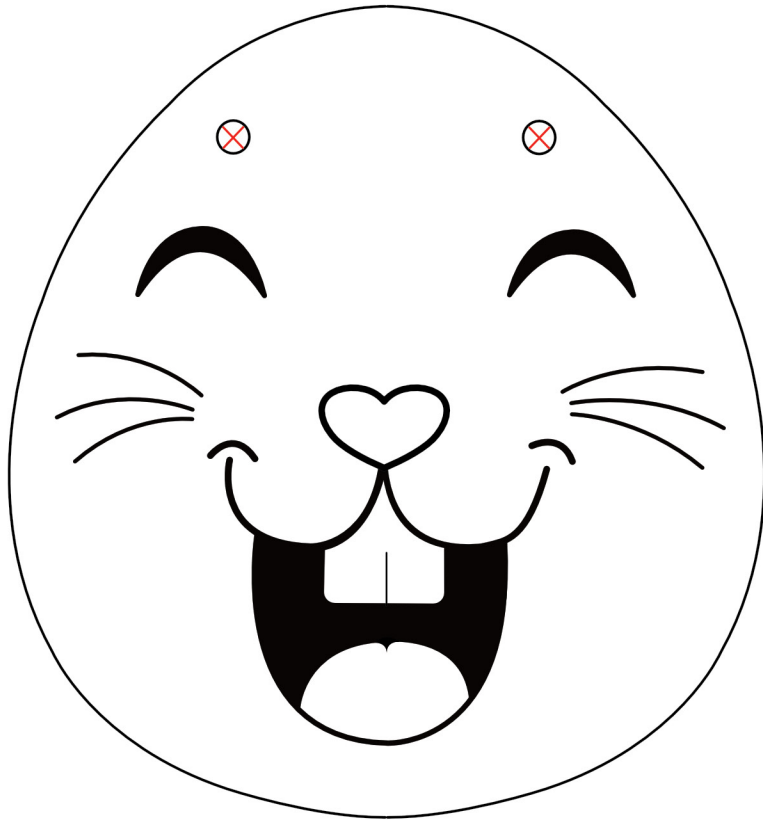


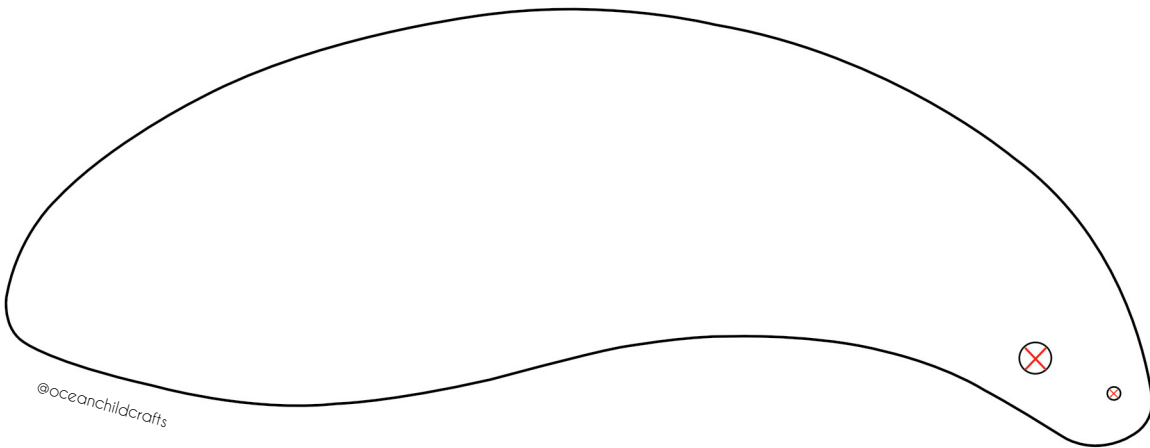
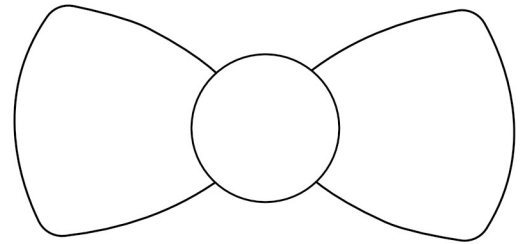
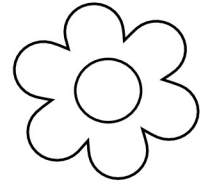
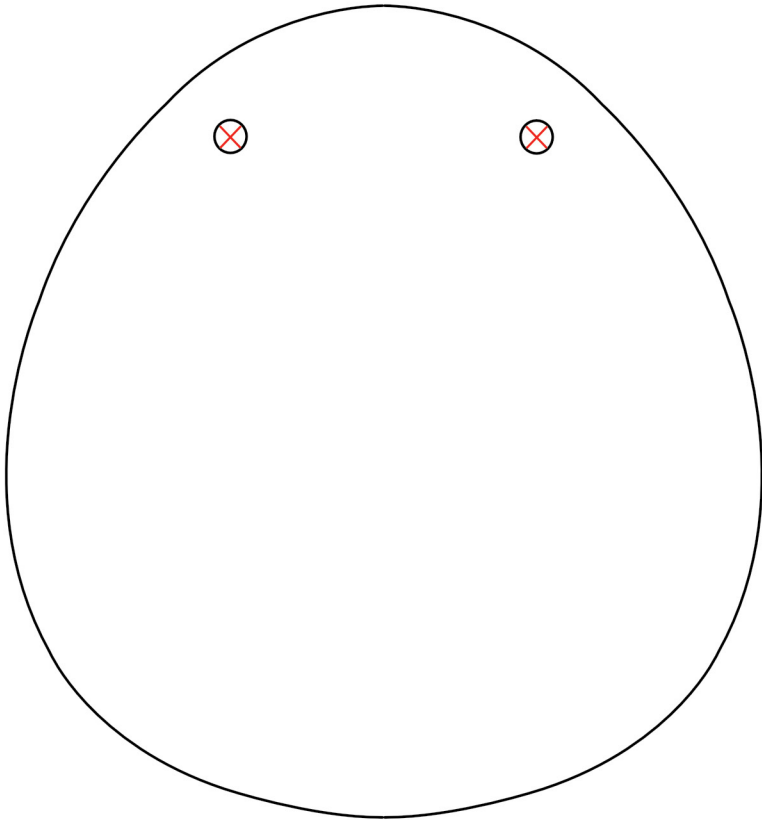
