

# CHRISTMAS TREE ORNAMENT CRAFT printable



### **HELLO, CRAFTY FRIENDS!**

Thank you for your purchase! Get ready to make your own adorable Christmas tree ornament. Kids can color, cut, and assemble a fun 3D tree to hang and enjoy. Whether you use the full-color or coloring version, this festive craft will bring smiles and holiday cheer. Let's get crafting!





### **INCLUDED**

- Instruction page (that's this one!)
- Christmas tree template in color
- Christmas tree template in color page
- · Blanco Christmas tree (get creative!)



### **CRAFT SUPPLIES**

- A (color) printer or printing service
- Scissors and a glue stick
- · Color pencils or crayons (coloring page)
- Yarn/ribbon and beads (optional)



## **PRINT INSTRUCTIONS**

When you print the printable, we highly recommend using thicker (heavier) paper than regular printing paper. This makes the crafting process easier for little hands and your Christmas tree more durable.

This printable is created on letter size 8'5 x 11" when printing on A4 file size, click "print to file size" by printing option.



### **STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS**

- L Choose and print your Christmas tree design: Pick your favorite version: full color, coloring page, or a blank tree to decorate yourself. Print it out and gather your craft supplies before you start.
- **2.** Add color (if you chose the coloring page): Get creative! Use crayons, markers, colored pencils, or even paints to make your Christmas tree bright and colorful. You can also sprinkle on some glitter for a festive sparkle (optional).
- 3. Cut out your Christmas tree pieces: Carefully cut along the outlines of the six triangles for your Christmas tree. You can cut right on the lines or leave a little white border, see the sample picture below for reference.
- Assemble your Christmas tree: Fold each triangle in half along the dashed line to create a clean crease (you can use a ruler and the back of a butter knife to help). Then, glue the six folded triangles together, one side at a time, to form a 3D shape. Once your 3D triangle is complete, glue it onto the tree template (marked glue area).
- **5.** Add a hanger Punch a hole at the top/star where the cross is marked. Thread a ribbon or some twine through, and add beads if you like. Voilà, your adorable Christmas tree ornament is ready to hang! It also makes a sweet handmade gift (tag) for someone special.
